

Non-Interventional Study CLEARLY

Aim

To evaluate the psychometric comparability of culturally adapted versions of the Alzheimer's Disease Cooperative Study Preclinical Alzheimer's Cognitive Composite (ADCS-PACC) compared to the US-English version.

Non-interventional study

A cross-sectional, multinational, noninterventional study to evaluate the psychometric comparability of versions of the ADCS-PACC.

Hypothesis

To conduct an evaluation of the psychometric comparability of translated, culturally adapted versions of the ADCS-PACC with the US-English source version, using scores from a sample of healthy normal elderly individuals with no cognitive impairment and a sample of elderly subjects with amnesic mild cognitive impairment.

Criteria

Participants must be 60–85 years old and not be demented. If 60–64 years of age, must be at-risk of Alzheimer's disease.

Duration of study

Assessments will be conducted over 2 visits, approximately 1 week apart.
